WILL WE BE RAPTURED
SEPTEMBER 23-24, 2025? PART 4

1. In this Sabbath School Lesson, we will study Revelation 10 which brings to view the history and birth of the Seventh-day Adventist movement and the antitypical application for the feast of trumpets in these last days. The feast of trumpets is a major focal point of Christians who are teaching that the rapture will occur September 23-24, 2025.

3. Which feast preceded the day of atonement, and on which day was it held? Leviticus 23:24

4. On which day of the month was the day of atonement held? Leviticus 23:27

5. **Note:** The sounding of a trumpet signaled that a message was going to be given and that the people should assemble (1 Samuel 13:3; Exodus 19:16, 19; Numbers 10:1-3). The feast of trumpets was a not only a feast of memorial, but was a feast that announced that the solemn day of atonement was near.

6. How much time would elapse until the cleansing of the sanctuary, the antitypical day of atonement? Daniel 8:14

7. **Note:** Since Gabriel came to give Daniel understanding about the 2300 prophetic days in Daniel 9:21-27 and introduced the 70 prophetic weeks, this means that both prophecies are connected. It also means that if we find the starting date for the 70 weeks prophecy, it will also be the starting date for the 2300 prophetic days. As we learned in our previous lessons, the going forth of the commandment to restore and build Jerusalem was given by King Artaxerxes I, in the 7th year of his reign: 457 B.C. When we go 2300 years into the future, it brings us to the year 1844 A.D.

8. **Note:** Since we know the starting date for the investigative judgment, October 22, 1844, we must see the fulfillment of the feast of trumpets prior to that date. Let's study, in part, Revelation 10 to discover when the antitypical feast of trumpets occurred.

9. **Further Study:** Read Revelation 10:1-11 for context. Who is this mighty angel? **Answer:** It is Jesus. An angel represents a messenger. Acts 7:30-32; Acts 6:8, 15; Galatians 4:14. We will confirm it is Jesus by using the identifying characteristics in Revelation 10:1, 3 (see below).

a) *Clothed with a cloud:* Jesus is clothed with a cloud. See Exodus 13:21; Acts 1:9; Daniel 7:13; Revelation 1:7; Revelation 14:14.

b) *Rainbow on His head:* Jesus has the rainbow over His head. The rainbow is above God's throne. Both Jesus and His Father share the throne. See Revelation 4:2, 3; Revelation 3:21. See also Genesis 9:13. This is the Messenger entering into covenant with His people.

c) *Face as the sun and feet as pillars of fire:* Jesus' countenance is as the sun and His feet as if they are burned in fire. See Revelation 1:13-16.

d) *He cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth:* It is Jesus whose voice is as a lion's roar. He is described as the lion from the tribe of Judah. See Revelation 5:5; Hosea 11:10; Amos 3:8.

10. What is this little book that Jesus opens? Revelation 10:2 **Answer:** Firstly, it is significant to note that this little book was once sealed, because Jesus opens it. This little book must refer to end-time prophecy. See Revelation 10:2, 5, 6. As we search the Holy Scriptures, there is only one book that has prophecies that were to be sealed until the end-time or the “time of the end.” It is the book of Daniel. Compare the scene in Daniel 12:4-7 with Revelation 10:2, 5, 6.

11. **Note:** The Bible states that the words or prophecies of Daniel would be opened and that knowledge of end-time prophecies would increase at “the time of the end” according to Daniel 12:4. The phrase “time of the end” is connected to the phrase “a time, times, and a half” which represents the 1260 years of Papal reign from 538 A.D. to 1798 A.D. (Daniel 12:4, 6, 7; Revelation 12:14; Revelation 12:6).

Therefore, Revelation 10 begins in 1798 because the little book was opened in that very same year. Furthermore, it is revealing that Jesus started and orchestrated a spiritual and a religious movement that begun sometime after 1798. The leaders of that movement emphasized the prophecies from the book of Daniel and the Revelation.

12. Once the little book is opened what is said? Revelation 10:6

13. What is longest time prophecy in the book of Daniel? Daniel 8:14

a) **Note:** Revelation 10:6 reveals the year 1844. Write 1844 beside Revelation 10:6. 1844 signaled the end of prophetic periods; in other words, there are no more prophetic events based on time setting. Hence, Christians who are teaching that Jesus will rapture His church September 23-24, 2025 are false teachers even though some of them might be sincere.

14. Which group of people were emphasizing the prophecies of Daniel, especially Daniel 8:14, and the prophecies of Revelation during the time period of 1798 to 1844? **Answer:** It was the Great Advent Movement with William Miller as the chief speaker.

15. When did William Miller begin preach about the Second Coming of Jesus? See below.

“In 1833 Miller received a license to preach, from the Baptist Church, of which he was a member. A large number of the ministers of his denomination also approved his work, and it was with their formal sanction that he continued his labors. He traveled and preached unceasingly, though his personal labors were confined principally to the New England and Middle States.” {GC 332.1}

“In 1833, two years after Miller began to present in public the evidences of Christ’s soon coming, the last of the signs appeared which were promised by the Saviour as tokens of His second advent. Said Jesus: “The stars shall fall from heaven.” Matthew 24:29. And John in the Revelation declared, as he beheld in vision the scenes that should herald the day of God: “The stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.” Revelation 6:13. This prophecy received a striking and impressive fulfillment in the great meteoric shower of November 13, 1833...” {GC 333.1}

16. **Note:** The feast of trumpets was 10 days before the day of atonement and the sounding of trumpets warned the people that the solemn feast was approaching. Likewise, approximately 10-11 years before the expected return of Jesus by the Millerite Adventists, the message was given to warn the world of Jesus’ Second Coming.

17. How widespread and extensive was the Millerite movement to be, based upon Bible prophecy? Revelation 10:2, 5
Answer: It was a worldwide movement. Consider that Jesus had the little book open with His feet covering land and sea. This position of His feet signifies that the revelation of Daniel’s prophecies would go worldwide. Indeed it did!

“In 1821, three years after Miller had arrived at his exposition of the prophecies pointing to the time of the judgment, **Dr. Joseph Wolff, “the missionary to the world,” began to proclaim the Lord’s soon coming.** Wolff was born in Germany, of Hebrew parentage, his father being a Jewish rabbi.” {GC 357.2}

“During the twenty-four years from 1821 to 1845, Wolff traveled extensively: in Africa, visiting Egypt and Abyssinia; in Asia, traversing Palestine, Syria, Persia, Bokhara, and India. He also visited the United States, on the journey thither preaching on the island of Saint Helena. He arrived in New York in August, 1837; and, after speaking in that city, he preached in Philadelphia and Baltimore, and finally proceeded to Washington. Here, he says, “on a motion brought forward by the ex-President, John Quincy Adams, in one of the houses of Congress, the House unanimously granted to me the use of the Congress Hall for a lecture, which I delivered on a Saturday, honored with the presence of all the members of Congress, and also of the bishop of Virginia,

and of the clergy and citizens of Washington. The same honor was granted to me by the members of the government of New Jersey and Pennsylvania, in whose presence I delivered lectures on my researches in Asia, and also on the personal reign of Jesus Christ.” —Ibid., pages 398, 399.” {GC 360.2}

18. Read Revelation 10:9-10. What is the meaning of the little book being sweet in the mouth but bitter in the belly? What did not occur on October 22, 1844 as the Millerites expected?

“And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up his hand to heaven, and swore by him that liveth for ever and ever, who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are, and the sea, and the things which are therein, that there should be time no longer’ (Revelation 10:5, 6). **This message announces the end of the prophetic periods. The disappointment of those who expected to see our Lord in 1844 was indeed bitter to those who had so ardently looked for His appearing. It was in the Lord's order that this disappointment should come, and that hearts should be revealed.**” {2SM 108.1}

19. Some people look at the Great Advent Movement with scorn because Jesus did not return in 1844. Like the early Adventist believers, the disciples of Jesus also experienced a great disappointment. What was their disappointment? Luke 24:19-21; John 6:15

20. As the early Adventist believers continued studying after the passing of October 22, 1844, what did they understand transpired on that date, which proves that the Adventist movement is not a false movement? Daniel 7:9-10, 13; Daniel 8:14
