THE ANTICHRIST IS HERE! WHO ARE THE 10 TOES & HORNS OF DANIEL & REVELATION?

1. In this Sabbath School Lesson, we will identify who represent some of the following symbols from the books of Daniel and Revelation, including the ten toes, the ten horns, the little horn and the beast of Revelation 13:1-3. This is a response to a video made by popular Christian YouTuber, Allen Parr.

2. In Daniel 2, King Nebuchadnezzar saw a statue comprised of various metals in his dream. What kingdom does the head of gold represent? Daniel 2:36-38

3. What kingdom does the breast and arms of silver represent? Daniel 5:24-31; Isaiah 13:17-19; Daniel 8:3, 20
-

4. What kingdom does the belly and thighs of brass represent? Daniel 8:5-7, 20-21
-

5. What kingdom do the legs of iron represent? Luke 2:1; John 19:19, 20
-

6. **Note:** The succession of kingdoms in the prophecies of Daniel 2 and 7 are the same. However, Daniel 7 gives us more description on the fourth kingdom of Rome and the power that succeeded it. Let's study a portion of Daniel 7 to identify who the ten toes of Daniel 2:41-42 and the ten horns of Daniel 7:7-8 represent.

7. Read Daniel 7:7. Notice that this dreadful and terrible beast (Roman Empire) has ten horns. What do the ten horns represent? Daniel 7:23-24

8. History shows us that the western Roman Empire was divided into ten divisions in the area of modern-day Europe. See the excerpt below.

"The division was made possible by several nations that were largely instrumental in the collapse and breaking up of the Roman Empire. **The groups that held Roman territories and formed their own kingdoms included the Franks, Huns, Visigoths, Ostrogoths, Heruli, Lombards, Anglo-Saxons, Suevi, Vandals, and Burgundians.** Each of the kingdoms established were independent from each other unlike the method followed by the Roman Empire."

9. What power arose among the ten divisions of the Roman Empire (modern Europe)? Daniel 7:23-25 **Answer:** The Papacy.
 10. Read Daniel 2:43. Since the Papacy arose out of the Roman Empire, it is also represented as the iron in the feet and toes of the image. Did the Papacy mingle with men and nations during its reign? **Answer:** Yes; the Papacy was given its power by Emperor Justinian in the year 538 A.D. and employed the armies of the European nations to war against so called "heretics."
 11. Let's now prove that the Papacy rose to power after the Roman Empire according to the Bible and history. Read Daniel 7:8. It says that a little horn came up among the ten horns. What did this little horn do to three of the other horns? Daniel 7:8
-

"Daniel considered the horns. Indications of a strange movement appeared among them. A little horn (at first little, but afterward more stout than its fellows) thrust itself up among them. It was not content quietly to find a place of its own, and fill it; it must thrust aside some of the others, and usurp their places. Three kingdoms were plucked up before it. This

little horn, as we shall have occasion to notice more fully hereafter, was the papacy. **The three horns plucked up before it were the Heruli, the Ostrogoths, and the Vandals. And the reason why they were plucked up was because they were opposed to the teaching and claims of the papal hierarchy, and hence to the supremacy in the church of the bishop of Rome.**" {DAR1909 132.4}

12. This little horn had a "mouth speaking great things." This does not mean that the little horn speaks wonderful or admirable things but rather, it means that it makes boastful claims. Compare Daniel 7:8, 25. Against whom were these "great words" directed towards? See also Revelation 13:5, 6

a) **Note:** As we compare scripture with scripture, we noticed that this little horn power of Daniel 7 is the same beast brought to view in Revelation 13:1-10. This is the antichrist power, with the Pope as its head, that will bring upon the world a time of trouble. Based on the previous points, the little horn power is a "little or small" nation that arose out of the Roman Empire (modern Europe). This little nation overthrew or uprooted three other nations (Heruli, Vandals, Ostrogoths). It was never satisfied with the power it wielded and always sought for more power along with absolute obedience from its subjects. It also speaks blasphemies and "great words" against God (John 10:30-33; Mark 2:5-7). This little horn power represents none other than the Papacy or Roman Catholicism. See the following reference for confirmation.

What is the smallest country in the world?

"It may be difficult to imagine, but there is a country in the world smaller than New York City's Central Park and one with a population smaller than a typical high-school class. 13. The Papacy also historically warred against God's saints. For how long did they war against the saints? Daniel 7:21, 25

14. **Note:** This "time, times, and the dividing of a time" points to 3 ½ prophetic years. We will deduce how many literal years this represents in the following points. Another representation of the Papacy, as the dragon, is brought to view in Revelation 12:13-14 and the same time frame is given. The dragon is seen persecuting the woman, a symbol of God's true church (Ephesians 5:25; Jeremiah 6:2; 2 Corinthians 11:2) "for a time, and times, and half a time."

15. Read Revelation 12:14 and then verse 6. How many prophetic days does the "time, times, and a half" represent? (The answer is in verse 6)

16. **Important Further Study:** There are twelve months (Genesis 8:13 & Esther 3:7) in a Biblical year and thirty days in a Biblical month (Genesis 7:11; 8:4 and then Genesis 7:24). Understanding that there are twelve months in a Biblical year, the 3 ½ prophetic years are equivalent to 42 prophetic months (12 x 3.5 = 42). The Bible is teaching us that the 42 prophetic months, the "time, times, and a half," and the 1260 prophetic days **ALL represent the same time period.** Using the day for a year principle (Ezekiel 4:6; Numbers 14:34), the 1260 prophetic days point to **1260 literal years of Papal reign** and persecution of God's saints from 538 A.D. to 1798 A.D.

17. The question we must now answer is, can the Papacy still be labeled as the little horn and antichrist power since she lost her control over the nations in 1798? The answer is yes! Read Daniel 7:21-22 and write down which phrases confirm that fact that she will soon regain power and again make war with God's people.

18. In Revelation 13:1-3, this beast is comprised of all the beasts we saw in Daniel 7. What is prophesied about the deadly wound of this beast, the Papacy? Revelation 13:3

19. **Note:** Read Revelation 17:12-13. Allen Parr uses this passage to argue that the ten horns are not here on the scene as yet. This scripture has two primary applications. **Firstly**, at the time when the apostle John was writing Revelation, he was living under the Roman Empire which had not yet been divided into ten divisions. The Papacy was not on the scene as yet. What John was describing was still future. **Secondly**, the ten horns giving their power to the beast also points to these last days when the Papacy will regain its power (religious and civil) over the nations to persecute God's commandment-keeping people. This part of the prophecy is rapidly reaching its complete fulfillment as we speak!

20. What will the Papacy force everyone on earth to receive once she has the assistance of the nations, even the United States of America? Revelation 13:15-17

21. While the Papacy, the nations, and apostate protestants are uniting against God and His truth, which group will not unite with them according to Daniel 2:43?

22. The seed of men represent those who accept Jesus and His truth (Genesis 3:15; Revelation 12:17). What keeps the "seed of men" from joining this ungodly union?
